

WATER HEATER LOAD MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT (2026)

_____ is presently a member of McCone Electric Co-op, Inc. and requests a controlled water heater under the load management water heater control program.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual and reciprocal benefit to the parties, it is hereby agreed by McCone Electric and the member as follows:

1. McCone Electric hereby agrees to supply a load controlled water heater, which will be controlled under the water heater load management control program. The controlled water heater will be provided for any allowed electric installation at a discounted rate. Members already enrolled in the water heater program will receive a discount on the purchase of a replacement water heater (from McCone Electric) and will be required to return the old load management control device. During the warranty period only, a water heater will be supplied with the current discount, if the water heater fails to the degree that repairs are not practical.
2. McCone Electric will not supply water heaters for installations other than domestic water heating. Water heaters are not to be used as boilers for heating systems. Services with long periods of non-usage during the year are not entitled to water heaters under this program (lake cabins, hunting cabins, etc.).
3. It is the member's responsibility to install and maintain the controlled water heater.
4. The member agrees to leave the water heater under load management control.
5. The member shall notify McCone Electric of any malfunction of the load management control equipment. McCone Electric will replace or repair the load management control equipment at no cost.
6. The member hereby grants to McCone Electric its agents and employees, the right to enter into and upon the member's premises for the purpose of inspecting the system, at a reasonable time, when the member is present.
7. McCone Electric shall not be liable to member for any damage or loss, which may be alleged to result from any malfunction of the system, or from power or energy interruptions. The water heater shall remain the sole and separate property of the member. The load management control equipment shall remain the sole and separate property of McCone Electric. Should either party cancel the agreement, the load control device shall be returned to McCone Electric. Should the load control device not be returned, the member will be billed the current replacement cost of a new load control device.
8. The member shall not tamper with, alter, or modify the load management control device and equipment so as to circumvent its operation.
9. I/We have read and fully understand the forgoing.
